The Acorns: Lower School Program K-5



Our elementary school program builds strong foundational skills across all academic areas while fostering confidence and curiosity. Our nature-focused, and arts-integrated education supports each child's unique growth and development. Together, we cultivate a love of learning and a culture of joy at school.

Lower School Program Highlights:

- **Our School Day:** Age-appropriate daily schedules featuring two recesses and specialized programs each day.
- **Language Learning:** Spanish language courses begin in kindergarten.
